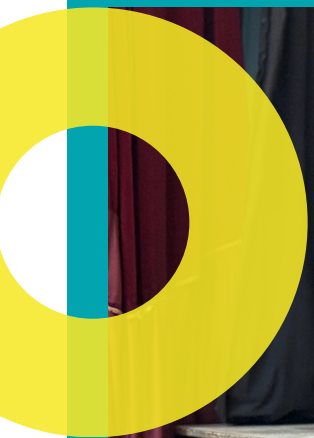

- **EDUCATIONAL GOALS:** Circus promotes physical activity, physical literacy, critical thinking, and reflective learning. It supports problem-solving and creative thinking, engaging young people with low motivation, low activity, transition concerns, and "fragile learners," improving physical competence. It's well-suited for neuro-diverse learners.
- **ENGAGEMENT GOALS:** Circus is fun and offers various disciplines, ensuring everyone can succeed. It's new for most, creating a level playing field. Programs can be adapted to different settings and needs, engaging people across genders, ages, cultural backgrounds, and identities.

- **DEVELOPMENT GOALS:** Circus is motivating and non-competitive, offering individual and group challenges. It encourages ambition through personal goal setting and helps overcome negative self-beliefs. Workshops and courses can be tailored to group and individual needs.
- **SOCIAL GOALS:** Circus boosts self-esteem, confidence, and teamwork. It fosters resilience, a "I can't do it yet!" mindset, and builds interpersonal relationships in a cooperative, safe, and non-judgmental environment.

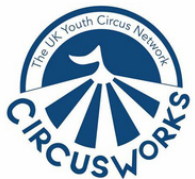
