



Covid-19 Secure Classes Protocol

Updated: 19th July 2021 (v7)

Entering and using the building:

1. You should not come to class if you or anyone in your household has any COVID 19 symptoms.
2. Try to keep social distance of 1m plus,
3. On arrival we will:
 - require you to clean your hands with hand sanitiser or soap and water at the sink, and ask you to do this before leaving the building
 - Check your temperature. Should it be over 38 degrees we will ask you to kindly not attend class.
4. We will ensure the ventilation system is on. Two switches are located behind the tallscope, with the speed set at speed 4 .
5. Whenever possible arrive in training clothes, to avoid use of shared toilets as changing rooms . Bring your own water bottle.
6. Bin lids will be left off or open so you do not need to touch them when disposing of paper towels
7. Do not use any kitchen appliances or crockery

Your training and equipment

1. PPE: Masks: you must wear masks in the building unless you are a child, exempt, taking part in a warm up or undertaking any activity where the mask creates undue risk to your training or inhibits the teachers ability to do their job.
2. To sanitise your hands between use of shared equipment.
3. You will clean your mats at the end of the session as instructed by the teacher
4. In the case of an accident or emergency, social distancing measures can be temporarily suspended as necessary
5. If you need a first aid item and it is not an emergency, ask a member of staff to get it for you
6. If you feel ill please inform the teacher and sit out the class in the lobby or arrange leave as soon as possible.
