Classic Circus Skills Workshop

A workshop in a range of hand held equipment such as diablo, plate spinning and juggling, as well as balancing equipment (tight-wire, unicycles, stilts etc.). There are a lot of possible skills that can be covered in this session, and actual content will depend on the age of the children, the number of children and any specific requests from you. The workshop can last for any length of time, but the most popular lengths are 90 minutes to 2 hours.

Cost is £60 / tutor / hour for the workshop, plus £30 / hour to hire our centre.

You can book your own venue if you prefer and we will run the workshop in it (£80/hour).

Aerial Workshop

This is an opportunity to try silks or static trapeze, on a low trapeze, supervised by an experienced tutor. It is an exciting option, but because beginners need one to one supervision we only take a group of six.

Cost is £60 / hour for the workshop, plus £30 / hour to hire our centre. We can only run this at our centre.

Classic Circus And Aerial Workshop

Combine both the above workshops by having a classic circus skills workshop for the whole group whilst a small number of children at a time step out of it to have an aerial workshop. Cost is £60 / tutor / hour for the two workshops (minimum two tutors), plus £30 / hour to hire our centre.

Clown Circus Show

We can book one of our entertainers to perform a half hour show featuring a range of circus skills, lots of comedy, volunteers and audience participation. I would need to check prices and availability of entertainers for a given date. You can also combine a show with any of the workshop options above.

FAQs

When can we come?

You can generally get into our centre 15 minutes before your booking starts in order to prepare before your guests arrive. If you need longer to prepare then you will probably need to hire the centre for longer. We expect you and your guests to have packed up and to leave at the end of the hire period.

Can we decorate the space?

Yes, you are welcome to bring balloons, banners and other items to decorate the centre to help create a special atmosphere for your party. Please put them up using blue tack or another method that doesn't damage the centre, and please take away with you at the end of the party.

This should be done within the hours that you have hired the centre for.

Can we bring food?

You are very welcome to bring food for your party. We have a seating area at one end of our main space where food can be laid out, and where the children can sit and eat. We have a kettle and a microwave, but no other means of heating food or drink.

Please take away all uneaten food, packaging, disposable plates etc. with you at the end of the party.

What to wear?

For a Classic Circus Skills workshop you can wear pretty much anything, although loose fitting, comfortable clothing would be best. T-shirts, sweat shirts, leggings, jogging pants etc. are all suitable.

For any aerial workshop please wear clothing which covers your skin (including a long sleeved top), but nothing with zips, studs etc. and no jewellery which may damage the equipment.

Also ensure nails are cut short. If the tutors consider that you are inappropriately dressed for any activity, you may not be allowed to take part and a refund will not be offered.
