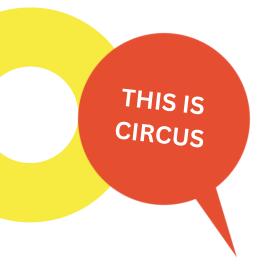
This Is Circus School Programme
